Membership Classes

- a. **CLASS A:** To qualify for Class A Membership, an applicant shall have at time of application for Membership, a minimum of three (3) years experience as a golf course superintendent and be employed in such capacities. Class A Members shall have all the privileges of the Association including voting and holding office.
- b. **SUPERINTENDENT MEMBER:** To qualify for Superintendent Member membership, an applicant shall, at the time of application, have less than three years of experience as a superintendent and be employed in such capacities. Superintendent Members shall have all the privileges of the Association, except for holding the offices of president, vice president, secretary or treasurer.
- c. **CLASS C:** To qualify for Class C Membership, an applicant shall, at the time of application for membership, be employed as an Assistant to a Golf Course Superintendent. Class C members shall have all the privileges of the Association, except for holding office.
- d. **AFFILIATE:** To qualify for Affiliate Membership, an applicant must be an individual interested in golf course management and/or in the growing of fine turfgrass, and who does not qualify for membership in another class. Affiliate Members shall have all the privileges of the Association, except for voting and holding office.
- e. **ASSOCIATE:** To qualify for Associate Membership, an applicant must be employed at a golf course and does not qualify for membership under the Class A, Superintendent Member or Class C Bylaws definition. Associate Members shall have all the privileges of the Association, except for voting and holding office.
- f. **FACILITY MEMBERSHIP:** A Facility Membership is available to those facilities that operate with limited resources. The membership is in the name of the facility, whose representative can be the superintendent, owner or other representative entrusted to the care of the golf facility. The Facility Member is entitled to all privileges of membership, except those of voting and holding office.
- g. **STUDENT:** To qualify for student membership, an applicant must be enrolled in a recognized two or four year turf management program or related field. Student members will have all the rights and privileges of the Association, except for voting and holding office.
- h. **EDUCATOR/MEDIA REPRESENTATIVE:** Any person who is a qualified educator or representative of the golf or turfgrass industry may be invited to be a member of the association annually. These invitations are to be at the NEGCSA Board of Directors' discretion. There shall be no dues for this classification, and they shall have all of the rights and privileges of the association except voting and holding office.
- i. **HONORARY:** Any person, who has in the past rendered exceptional service to this Association, or whose membership would add dignity and prestige to the Association, may be elected to Honorary membership. Lifetime Achievement Award winners become Honorary Members. Honorary members shall have all the rights and privileges of this Association and shall not be required to pay dues.
- j. **RETIRED:** Any Class A, Superintendent Member or Class C, who is retired from active employment as a Golf Course Superintendent or assistant, and having been a member of the association for at least ten (10) years, will qualify for Retired membership, with all the privileges of the Association except for holding office. These members will not be required to pay dues. Those meeting the above criteria with less than ten (10) years as a member of the association will receive a 50% discount on their normal membership class dues.
